
TERMS OF BUSINESS

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

These terms of business (the “Terms of Business”) apply to purchases on www.poulschmith.com (the “Website”) provided by:

2. ORDERING

When ordering on the Website, you must provide your name, surname, job title, mobile number, e-mail, name of business or authority, and billing details.

When you click “Sign up”, it will say “Success”. You will subsequently receive confirmation by e-mail.

We have only entered into a binding agreement when you have received confirmation.

We accept no liability for incorrect prices, misprints and technical errors. We reserve the right to cancel and change courses/events, including change of time, place, programme or speaker.

3. DEROGATION FROM THE E-COMMERCE ACT

We comply with all mandatory information obligations set out in the Danish E-Commerce Act (Act no. 227 of 22 April 2002). In accordance with section 13(2) of the E-Commerce Act, the following provisions do not apply when you order on the Website:

4. PRICES AND PAYMENT

4.1 Prices

All prices on our Website are stated in Danish kroner (DKK) excluding VAT.

4.2 Means of payment

All payment takes place through invoices. We use electronic invoicing.

4.3 Payment terms

Invoices are sent electronically immediately after the course/event to which the payment relates.

The time allowed for payment is 21 days from the date of invoice. In case of late payment or non-payment, you will be charged the usual default interest and compensation pursuant to the Danish Interest Act, and we will send you a reminder letter with a fee.

5. DEREGISTRATION AND CANCELLING OF COURSES/EVENTS

5.1 Terms and conditions of deregistration

If you are prevented from attending a course/event, you may deregister free of charge up to two days before the course/event starts. If you deregister two days or later before the course/event starts, we reserve the right to charge the full fee for the course/event.

If you register later than two days before the course/event starts, your registration will be binding and, unfortunately, it will not be possible for you to deregister from the course/event.

5.2 Cancellation or rescheduling of courses/events

We reserve the right to cancel or reschedule our courses/events. This will typically only occur if there are not enough participants or if the course cannot be held due to unforeseen circumstances, including sudden illness of instructors.

If we cancel the course/event, no course/event fee will be charged.

6. LIABILITY

Our liability is in all respects limited to the course/event fee paid and we are not liable for any indirect or consequential losses, including loss of profit, loss of turnover or other financial consequential losses.

The content of the material provided, including course material etc., does not constitute and cannot replace legal advice. We are not responsible for any errors and omissions in the material provided.

Nor are we liable for any unnecessary costs as a result of our cancelling or rescheduling a course/event, see 5.2 above, including costs of transportation, hotel etc.
